

Muslim World League, Origin, Development, Goals And Services

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Abstract

The Muslim World League was founded in 1962 to promote Islamic teachings and principles, defend the interests of Muslims, and support education and relief work. It aims to promote cooperation and understanding among Muslims and between Muslims and non-Muslims, protect the sanctity of Islamic sites, and combat extremism and discrimination in the name of religion. It also works towards peaceful coexistence and a just international order based on human rights and social justice. The League has observer status in various international organizations, and its headquarters are located in Mecca, Saudi Arabia. Its highest legislative body is the General Islamic Conference, and it has a Supreme Council for Islamic Affairs and a World Supreme Council of Mosques

Origin of the Muslim world league

It was founded by a decision issued by the Islamic World Conference held in Mecca Saudi Arabia on 14 Dhul-Hijjah 1381 AH corresponding to May 18, 1962 AD. ^[1] The members of the Constituent Council of the League were chosen to represent the different Islamic people with the scholars who presided over the Islamic sectors in their countries. The tenth of the month of Dhu al-Hijjah 1384 AH corresponding to the seventeenth of April 1965 AD. ^[2] In order to achieve its goals, it uses means that do not contradict the provisions of Islamic law The association is represented by:

The United Nations is an observer member of the Economic and Social Council among

international non-governmental organizations in consultative status. ^[3]

Organization of Islamic Cooperation as an observer; attends summits, conferences of foreign ministers, and all conferences of the organizations

The United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) as a member of the Muslim world league. ^[3]

The International Islamic Council for Call and Relief IICDR as a member, of the Muslim world league.

The Supreme Council for Islamic Affairs as a member of the Muslim world league.

The headquarters of Muslim world league

The Association is located in Mecca on a land area of 53,000 square meters, and consists of a building in five floors for administrative offices, parking lots, conference building, a mosque, a library, and warehouses, which is a gift fahad, may God have mercy on him.

Secretariat

It is the executive body of the Association, and it works on direct supervision of the work and activities. The Secretary-General, with the assistance of the secretaries and the Association's employees and employees, undertakes the implementation of the plans and directives issued by the Supreme Council, located in Mecca Al-Mukarramah. ^[5]

Muslim World league Activities

World Islamic Conference

The General Islamic Conference is the highest legislative body and consists of a group of senior advocates of Islam who meet to consider major Islamic issues and work to solve Muslims' problems and achieve their interests. The General Islamic Conference was held several times:

- The first General Islamic Conference was held in 1381 AH corresponding to 1962 AD, and the Association was established based on its decision.
- The Second General Islamic Conference was held in 1384 AH corresponding to 1965 AD.
- The Third General Islamic Conference in 1408 AH corresponding to 1987 AD, whose most important recommendations were the necessity of believing in the sanctity of the Two Holy Mosques, the veneration of Mecca and the sacred months and rituals of Hajj, and that the security of the Two Holy Mosques is entrusted to the Muslims who follow it.

The Fourth General Islamic Conference was held in the year 1423 AH corresponding to 2002 AD. The conference issued the Mecca Charter for Islamic Action, issued a statement on Palestine, and issued a decision to form a supreme body for coordination and an international forum for Muslim scholars and thinkers.

Constituent assembly

The Constituent Assembly is the supreme authority in the Association that approves all plans adopted by the General Secretariat of the Association. The Constituent Assembly of the Muslim World League consists of (60) members, representing Muslim peoples and minorities, and they are appointed by the decision of the Council.

The World Supreme Council of Mosques

The International Supreme Council of Mosque is a corporate body that performs what activates and rationalizes the architecture of the mosque, so that the mosque becomes a vital starting point for all matters related to the religious and worldly lives of Muslims, and performs the function that it was performing in the early days of Islam. Protecting mosques and Islamic endowments from attacks on them and their property, preserving their sanctity and purity, and maintaining and caring for them. It consists of the members representing the Islamic peoples and societies in the world, and its work is voluntary, and its members do not receive any salary or remuneration.

Association representation

The Association is represented by the Organization of the Islamic Conference as an observer member; Summits, conferences and conferences of foreign ministers attend the United Nations as an observer member of the Economic and Social Council among international and non-governmental organizations with consultative status and their organizations, such as: Education and Culture Organization (UNESCO) as a member, and the International Children's Organization (UNICEF) as a member. Islamic Educational systems

Islamic Fiqh Council

It is an Islamic scientific body with an independent legal personality, within the framework of the Muslim World League, made up of a selected group of Islamic jurists and scholars. The main purpose of the establishment of the Council are summarized in the study of emerging issues in the world that require the consideration of scholars, whether within Islamic countries, or in non-Islamic countries where Muslim minorities live, in terms of legitimate answers to calamities and burning issues. The Council of the Fiqh Council consists of 24 members, including the president and his deputy, and work in it is voluntary and its members do not receive a salary or remuneration. [8]

International Organization for the Qur'an and the Sunnah

A body emanating from the Muslim World League, global in performance with an independent legal personality, serving the Noble Qur'an, generalizing its memorization and advancing its performance, and seeking to show the different aspects of scientific miracles in the Qur'an and Sunnah and work to spread them in

the world, and to introduce the Messenger of Mercy, Muhammad, may God's prayers and peace be upon him, his Sunnah and his support, and to correct the misconception that you target it. It was established by a decision of the Supreme Council of the League in its thirty-sixth session held in Mecca Al-Mukarramah from (4-6 Shaban 1421 AH) and its name was amended by a decision of the Executive Council of the Supreme Council of the Muslim World League on 2 Ramadan 1438 AH to be called the World Organization for the Book and the Sunnah. International Council of Muslim Scholars

It is one of the bodies of the Muslim World League with an independent legal personality, which was established in implementation of the decision of the Fourth General Islamic Conference held in Mecca Al-Mukarramah in 1423 AH. Unifying the efforts of scholars, enhancing their status, strengthening the relationship between them, collecting the word of the Islamic nation, preserving its identity, building effective strategic partnerships with peoples and international organizations, and finding solutions to meet contemporary challenges. International Relief, Welfare and Development Authority

It is one of the ripe fruits of the goodness of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, and it provides its various services from relief to educational, social, health and development in most countries of the world through its offices and representatives in 95 countries. The organization is an Islamic charitable organization emanating from the Muslim World League, with a global performance and cooperating with benefactors to provide their donations to their needy and afflicted brothers in the world. In addition to its relief work, the authority is concerned with sponsoring orphans, spreading the call, building mosques, schools, education and vocational

training centers, and digging wells. The authority is an effective member of the international relief system, which has earned it the confidence of the United Nations organizations working in the field of relief, to supervise the implementation of its programs in many countries of the world and disaster areas. ^[11]

The cover of the magazine was decorated with a picture of the Grand Mosque, with the Kaaba in the middle, and the name of the magazine "The League of the Islamic World" was written on the top of the colored cover, and below it was written "Monthly magazine...issued in Makkah Al-Mukarramah.." The Muslim World League..the responsible editor-in-chief Hussain Abdullah Siraj" and the second box in which the title, letters, and transfers were written in the name of the editor-in-chief..the Muslim World League, and the issue included the following places:

Muslim world league zakat for Refugees

The Muslim world league has issued a fatwa permitting giving zakat to eligible refugees and internally displaced people through the Refugee zakat fund, so long as the receipt and Distribution of zakat are done according to the Islamic rules, most important of which includes the 100 % zakat distribution policy whereby beneficiaries among Refugees and IDPs receive the entirety zakat funds.
